SESSION 1

MEETING AT THE CROSSROADS: Where Faith & Life Intersect

If life is truly a journey, we face crossroads each day. At this place is where we must learn how our faith and our daily lives intersect. Using the story of Ruth and Naomi, we will learn how to follow the right road and fix our eyes on Jesus to walk by faith and not fear.

SESSION 2

Once we understand what it means to follow Jesus, we need to put Him at the center of our lives. We need to connect with Him daily through prayer, worship, solitude, and Bible study. SESSION 3

THE PATH OF CONNECTION: Serving Others with Purpose & Intentionality

God has a specific purpose and plan for each of our lives. How do we live a life with meaning? How do we know what God wants us to do and where He wants us to go? God has called each and every one of us to impact our sphere of influence by serving and loving others well. There are practical things we can do to make a difference right where we are with what we have.

SESSION 4

THE PEOPLE OF CONNECTION: Supporting Each Other

Are you a Girl of Division or a Woman of Connection? Do you compare or champion? Compete or cooperate? Criticize or communicate? We need each other as women! God designed and created us to grow and thrive within the context of a caring and committed community. By sharing our stories with grace and truth, we can come alongside each other to encourage, inspire, challenge, and support. This session is an audience favorite and functions as a workshop providing women with the tools they need to authentically connect.
